Our Objectives will be to:

- Sequence short narratives orally and pictorially
- Name the letters of the alphabet in order
- Compose phrases and sentences orally
- Show an awareness of how full stops are used in Writing or Reading
- Organise writing correctly (top to bottom, left to right)
- Distinguish between lower case letters and capital letters

MUSIC

Exploring Sound

Our Music focus will be exploring instruments and the sounds they make.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Play tuned and un-tuned instruments musically.
- Experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using inter-related dimensions of music.
- Play instruments at different volumes and paces.
- Play instruments in time with music and known songs.
- Learn about the beat and rhythm in music.

GEOGRAPHY/HISTORY

My life, my world

During topic lessons we will be exploring different aspects of this term's overall theme - looking at where we live and our families.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Ask and answer the question 'Who was here before me?'
- Ask and answer the question 'Who/ what made my corner of the world special long ago?'
- Create a fact file about a grandparent/older relative.
- Use world maps to identify the UK in its position in the world.
- Use a simple picture map to move around the school.
- Use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of their school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment.

MATHS

Place value and number bonds, doubling, shapes, mental addition and subtraction

Our Objectives will be to:

- Estimate and count groups of up to 30 objects.
- Find number bond pairs.
- Double numbers 1-5.
- Find 1 and 2 more and begin to count back to find 1 less.
- Recognise, name and describe simple shapes.
- Recognise basic line symmetry.
- Sort 2D shapes according to their properties.
- Read and write numbers and number-names to 20.
- Compare and order number sets.

- Know that computers need precise instructions.

ART/DT

My life, my world

Our focus for this half term will be inspired by our topic 'My life, my world'. Our main project will be designing, making and decorating picture frames.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Develop controlled printing against outline /within cut out shapes.
- Design purposeful, functional, appealing products for themselves and other users based on design criteria.
- Develop understanding of 2D and 3D in terms of artwork.
- Generate, develop, model and communicate their ideas through talking and drawing.
- Use a range of materials creatively to design and make products.
- Assemble, join and combine materials and components
- Use simple fixing materials

SCIENCE

The Human Body

Our Objectives will be to:

- Understand that people change as they get older but often retain recognisable features.
- Identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body.
- Say which part of the body is associated with each sense.
- Explore each of the 5 senses.
- Work scientifically - observe photographs, identify changes and use these to suggest answers to questions.

PE

We will be taking part in PE on Monday and Wednesday afternoons. The children will need their PE kits for these days. We will be doing basic skills and games, as well as gymnastics.

RE

Traditions, celebrations and festivals - Harvest

During our RE lessons, we will be exploring what Harvest means to Christians and Jews.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Discuss the traditions, celebrations and festivals we celebrate.
- Understand what 'Harvest' means.
- Think about how we thank people.
- Understand how Christians celebrate Harvest.
- Know how Jews celebrate Sukkot.
