

ENGLISH

Texts linked to Traditional Tales and Famous Folk

Our Objectives will be to:

- Write short narratives based on real and fictional experiences
- Use a simple plan (e.g. storyboard, flowchart)
- Re-read what has been written to check it makes sense
- Make simple changes to writing where suggested
- Read aloud writing clearly enough to be heard by peers
- Continue to develop use of sentence structure and punctuation

We will be sending spellings home for you to practice with your child. Please see the list of words in the front of their reading diary.

MATHS

Number & Place Value; Addition & Subtraction; Multiplication & Division; Fractions; Shape

Our Objectives will be to:

- Count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number.
- Counts in multiples of twos, fives and tens (begin to link to 2x,5x,10x tables).
- Given a number, identify one more and one less.
- Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in words.
- Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero.
- Solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction, and missing number problems such as $7 = ? - 9$.
- Recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object, shape or quantity; and one half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.
- Solve one step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays.

ART/DT

Sculpture

Our main project this half term will be making clay sculptures, taking inspiration from Antony Gormley and Elizabeth Frink.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Draw portraits, carefully observing from photographs and drawings
- State the purpose of the design and the intended user
- Measure, mark out, cut out and shape materials and components
- Begin to collect ideas in sketchbooks
- Look at sculptures by known artists and natural objects as starting points for own work

MUSIC

Music and Story

We are going to spend our Music lessons exploring how music and sound effects can be added. We will explore different instruments, volume, pace and pitch to create different effects.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Play tuned and untuned instruments musically
- Experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using the inter-related dimensions of music
- Work cooperatively in groups and as a class

- Investigate what happens to plants if they are not given water, light or soil

During topic lessons we will be learning about Famous people from the past including Christopher Columbus and Grace Darling.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Discuss and explore events beyond living memory that are significant nationally and globally
- Investigate the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements
- Communicate understanding of the past in a variety of ways
- Identify and discuss key human features, inc. city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour, shop
- Create a fact file about a famous person.
- List the places a famous explorer visited.

PE

We will be taking part in PE on **Wednesday and Thursday afternoons**. The children will need their PE kits for these days. We will be practicing Games skills and receive Cricket coaching.

RE

Judaism

During our RE lessons, we will be learning about the Jewish faith and what it means for someone to belong to Judaism.
