Non-fiction instructions/Narrative

In English this half term we will be exploring the book 'Stone Age Boy' by Satoshi Kitamura. We will then be looking at features of instruction texts before writing our own.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Begin to use paragraphs to group related sentences.
- Use different planning methods before writing.
- Start to understand the audience and purpose of different types of writing.
- Discuss and record ideas through writing and diagrams.
- Use a range of connectives and conjunctions.
- Use a range of punctuation including commas in a list, exclamation marks and question marks.

- Create a basic wiki

MATHS

Place Value / Addition and Subtraction

Our Objectives will be to:

- Recognise the place value of each digit in a three -digit number
- Compare and order numbers up to 1000
- Read and write numbers up to 1000 in numerals and in words.
- Add and subtract numbers mentally, including: a three-digit number and ones, tens and hundreds.
- Add and subtract numbers with up to three digits, using formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction.
- Estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operations to check answers.
- Solve problems, including missing number problems, using number facts, place value, and more complex addition and subtraction.

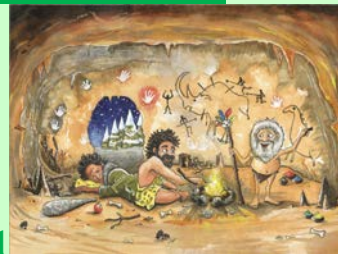
SCIENCE

Rocks and Soils

Our Objectives will be to:

- Compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties
- Research how rocks are formed
- in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock
- Recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter
- Research into how soil is formed

Sticks and Stones

HISTORY

This half term we will be looking at the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Develop a chronologically secure knowledge and understanding of British history
- Understand that knowledge about the past is constructed from a variety of sources.
- Ask and answer questions about the past, considering aspects of change, cause, similarity and difference and significance.

RE

This half term we will be learning about Signs and Symbols.

Our Objectives will be to: Recognise meanings contained in stories, objects and signs. Understand how symbols help believers to express the concept of God Identify how religious symbols used in places of worship, such as a Church

FRENCH

Our focus this term will be on the topic of Moi.

Our Objectives will be to learn:

- Greetings
- Comment tu t'appelles/ Au revoir
- Numbers 1-20
- Quel âge as-tu
- Sur le Pont d'Avignon.

ART

Our focus this half term will be to learn about art in the Stone Age.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Create sketch books to record our observations.
- Improve mastery of art and design techniques including drawing and painting with a range of materials including paintbrushes made from natural materials.

D&T

In D&T this half term we will explore diet during the Stone Age and compare it to our own.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Understand and apply the principles of a healthy and varied diet.
- Prepare and cook savoury dishes using a range of cooking techniques.
- Understand seasonality and know where and how a variety of ingredients are grown, reared, caught and processed.

MUSIC

Our Objectives will be to:

- Use and understand staff and other musical notations
