- Begin to use spelling patterns - Add s and es; Suffixes ing, ed, er;

MUSIC

Our Music focus will be on singing Pirate themed songs and creating sound effects.

Our Objectives will be to:

- Play tuned and untuned instruments musically
- Experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using the inter-related dimensions of music
- Use rhythm, pace and pause in singing and playing
- Use musical instruments to add sound effects to video clips

GEOGRAPHY/HISTORY

A Pirates Life For Me!

Our Objectives will be to:

- Identify different ways that the past is represented, e.g. fictional accounts, illustrations, films, song, museum displays
- Choose and use parts of stories and other sources to show understanding of events
- Communicate understanding of the past in a variety of ways
- Identify and discuss key human features, inc. city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour, shop
- Identify and discuss key physical features, including: beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation, season and weather

MATHS

Multiplication & Division; Fractions; Number (to 100); Money; Time

Our Objectives will be to:

- Count in 2s, 5s, 10s
- Make equal groups, use repeated addition, form arrays and practice grouping and sharing
- Halving shapes or objects; Halving a quantity
- Find a quarter of a shape or object; Find a quarter of a quantity
- Counting to 100, comparing numbers, ordering numbers, finding one more and one less.
- Recognising coins and notes; counting in coins
- Telling the time to the hour and half hour; Writing times on clock faces and in words
