Play the 'I went shopping game'. Each player takes turns to say 'I went shopping and I bought a...' the item they bought must begin with the letters of the alphabet starting with a,b,c and so on. You must try to remember what other people have bought too. Use the alphabet to help you to remember. e.g. Player 1: When I went shopping I bought an apple. Player 2: When I went shopping I bought an apple and a ball. Carry on in this way.	Have a go at these action patterns: -Arms up, arm down, arms up, arms down -Clap clap stamp stamp, clap clap stamp stamp, -Jump jump jump wiggle, jump jump jump wiggle, jump jump jump wiggle, jump jump jump wiggle, -Head toes toes head, head toes toes head, head toes toes head, head toes toes head, head toes toes head.	Can you design a mode of transport to get to Australia? Can you build this with Lego or other resources in your home?	Draw a picture then without showing it to your family, can you describe what you have drawn and see who can draw the best copy?
Go for a walk with your family. Can you draw a picture of what you saw then write a sentence about it using capital letters and full stops?	Roll two dice. How many tens? How many ones? Can you add the digits together? What is 1 more than your answer? What is 1 less than your answer? Can you repeat this game 5 times?	Find a favourite toy, talk to and adult and compare it to their favourite toy when they were your age.	Practice throwing and catching a ball with different members of your family.
How many words can you think of containing the 'sh' sound? Can you write down the words?	Design and build a model using any materials you have in your house. How tall is your model? What shapes have you used?	When you are out for a walk, talk to your adult about the flowers you see. What are they? Are they garden plants or wild plants?	Eat a family meal together then help to clear the table and wash up.
Read a story together. How many of these words can you see in the pages? One, school, today, the, said, were, where, come, friend.	Draw a map of your street. Can you give direction to get to places on your map? How many turns would you have to make to get to the different places you have drawn?	Can you paint, draw or make a mosaic of a rainbow and put this in your window?	Snuggle up at bed time and read a story together. Talk about your favourite part of the story.
Keep a diary about what you have done this week. Can you write a few sentences each day, using capital letters and full stops? Don't forget to write which day it is first.	Play the tray game to test your memory. Ask an adult to put 10 objects on a tray. Look at the objects for 20 seconds. Turn around while the adult removes an object. Can you see what is missing?	Can you set the table for a family meal?	Look through some family photographs and share your memories.
