Each sentence must include 2 adjectives.</p> <p>Complete 20 minutes a day on your new Spelling Shed assignment. Login details have been sent to your grown-ups. Then try creating a hive and sending the code to a friend so you can compete against them.</p> | <p>Log into maths shed. Go to lessons, stage 4, Spring term, block 1 and lesson 2. Place each of the eggs in a different liquid for the next week.</p> <p>Predict what you think will happen to each of the eggs and give a reason you're your prediction. Take observations (through drawings, writing or photos) of what happens to the eggs each day. Was your prediction correct?</p> |
