In English during this half term, we will be reading *How to Bee* by Bren MacDibble and using this as a stimulus to write a range of texts.

We will be exploring:

- Persuasion
- Discussion
- Narrative writing with a dilemma

## Maths


In Maths during this half term, our objectives will focus on:

- Identifying, comparing and measuring angles in degrees.
- Exploring the properties and different representations of 2D and 3D shapes.
- Investigating translation and reflection on a grid with reference points.
- Revising formal written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.



## Science

In Science during this half term, our focus will be to explore changes of state.



We will be learning to:

- Explore different states of matter.
- Understand how changes in states of matter occur and why this happens.
- Understand how the water cycle works and how evaporation, transpiration and precipitation are interlinked.

## History

In History this term, our focus will be to investigate why the Romans marched through County Durham and what impact they have had.



We will be learning to:

- look at causes and consequences of events.
- identify the key points made by an interpretation, linking primary sources
- explore features of Roman life.

## PE

We will be taking part in PE on **Wednesday and Friday**. The children will need to come to school in their PE kits for these days.

We will be learning to improve our running. Jumping and throwing skills in athletics and explore our teamwork skills in rounders.



## RE

This half term in RE, we will be exploring the religion of Hinduism and what followers of this religion believe.

We will be learning to:

- How beliefs impact on individuals and communities.
- Explore the Hindu beliefs of reincarnation and karma.



## Computing

In computing this half term, our focus will look at computer programming.

We will be learning to:

- Create our own games by moving a sprite through a platform level.
- Debug programmes to fix problems.
- Set commands to aid in gameplay.



## Art

In Art this term our focus will be exploring the world around us.

We will be learning to:

- Use sketch books to record their observations and use them to review and revisit ideas
- To improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting & sculpture.
